COVID News

Schools still have a number of guidelines that will be followed during Term 1. These are as follows:

- Parents can enter school grounds, however, are required to maintain 1.5 metre social distancing at all times. A face mask should be worn if 1.5metres cannot be maintained.
- Students are not required to wear masks in primary school.
- Teachers are not required to wear masks unless where they are in a situation where social distancing with other adults is not possible.
- Hand hygiene will be practised throughout the day. This includes hand-washing and use of sanitiser.
- Our school cleaners will be providing extra cleaning and sanitation after each school day for high touch areas.
