

## **Dear Parents and Carers**





Many children in our school have indicated that they have accounts on a variety of social media platforms. It is important for parents to know that each social media site and app has its own criteria for minimum age requirements.

Most require users to be at least 13 years of age before they can register, although some sites are created especially for children under the age of 13.

Both the physical age of your child and their level of maturity and resilience can affect their ability to have positive experiences on social media. The age restrictions sometimes reflect the nature of the posts and information that can be access on these sites and apps and also to comply with laws to stop the collection of personal information from children.

Here are the icons of some of the most commonly used apps and social media sites and their minimum age rating.





What's your favourite season and why? I love autumn. Warm days and crisp mornings are just the best; it's also my birthday season.


*What's your guilty pleasure?* I love anything with cooked apple in it. Apple pie, apple crumble, apple strudel, apple slice, stewed apples.
